



Grading Policy:

Credit Recovery: For a passing grade in the PASS/FAIL system you must pass **each unit** with a 70% grade or higher.

Honors, AP, and Regular: You may choose to take classes PASS/FAIL or for a letter grade.

- For a passing grade in the PASS/FAIL system you need 70% grade or higher.
- For the full scale grades letter grades will be assigned according to the following point system:

93.0-100 = A	87.0-89.9 = B+	77.0-79.9 = C+	67.0-69.9 = D+	< 60 = F
90.0- 92.9 = A-	83.0-86.9 = B	73.0-76.9 = C	60.0-66.9 = D	
	80.0-82.9 = B-	70.0-72.9 = C-		

NWLS does not round up.

Letter grades indicate the quality and effort students demonstrate in a course

- A – indicates consistent quality work and excellent effort
- B – indicates good quality work and good effort
- C – indicates inconsistent work and inconsistent effort

Students must earn a “C” to pass the course.

World Language: The above grading scale is the same, however your grades are weighted as follows:

Assignments – 25% of your final grade

Quizzes – 15% of your final grade

Tests – 60% of your final grade

Participation: Participation is required in all of the classes by participating in the online discussions. Each discussion is factored into your final grade.

Extra credit: Extra credit is determined on a case by case basis. If you are within 15 points of moving up a letter grade your teacher can allow you to have an extra credit assignment. However if 15 points won't make a difference in your overall grade extra credit is not offered.
