



# How To Submit An Assignment to TurnItIn.com

1. Go to our website [www.northwestlibertyschool.org](http://www.northwestlibertyschool.org) login to your TII account.

2. From your dashboard click on the corresponding class. This will take you to the "Class Homepage."

3. Find the assignment number for the assignment you want to turn in. Click the "Submit" button.

4. Enter a "submission title"

5. Choose your file.

6. Click the Upload button.

7. Click the Confirm button. You will receive an email verification of your assignment being turned in.
